Thank you for participating in an ISSCR event. Your contributions make it possible for the ISSCR to develop exceptional scientific programs for the global stem cell community.

Please review the following speaker policies and permissions, and affirm your understanding and agreement with the terms.

ISSCR Research Conduct Policy

By agreeing to speak at an ISSCR event, the speaker confirms that the reported research has been conducted in accordance with relevant institutional and national guidelines, regulations regarding experiments on human subjects, live vertebrates or higher invertebrates, and the [ISSCR Guidelines for Stem Cell Research and Clinical Translation](#).

ISSCR Research Communication Policy

The ISSCR is committed to ensuring that the public presentation of stem cell research and its applications are done responsibly to avoid misrepresentation of the work and misleading the public (see Recommendation 4.1, [ISSCR Guidelines for Stem Cell Research and Clinical Trials](#)). This is especially important for sensitive areas of research including chimeras, embryo models, and some brain organoid studies. For example, [the ISSCR advises against](#) using the term “synthetic embryo” to describe stem cell-based embryo models. To ensure accurate representation of the science presented at ISSCR meetings, we may request that speakers revise the language used in their titles, abstracts or presentations.

Permission for Use of Name and Likeness

Speaker grants the ISSCR, its agents, and representatives the right to use their name and likeness in promotional and other material published in relation to ISSCR meetings and programs.

Conflict of Interest Disclosure Policy

Speaker agrees to disclose any financial, intellectual, or other relationships with commercial interests that constitute a potential or real conflict of interest (COI) to the ISSCR. This information must be disclosed to attendees verbally and/or displayed on a slide at the beginning of each presentation, regardless of whether a COI exists.

Permission for Publication, Recording and Use of Material

- Speaker grants the ISSCR copyright to use video, audio, and slide recordings of the speaker’s presentation for inclusion in the conference or webinar proceedings. The speaker also grants the ISSCR permission to make the recording available on-demand to ISSCR members and event attendees. The



speaker understands that the recording will not be made available for individual use.
